254 pupils (147 girls and 107 boys) in Year 11

239 – 94.1% - gained at least 5 A* - C grades in GCSE and equivalents

(138 girls (94%) and 106 boys (95%).

(99.6% gained at least one A*-G) (1 pupil took no exams due to illness.)

Average Points GCSE score per pupil was **491** and capped point score (best 8 results) was **382**
