WHAT DO I DO IF I NEED SOMEONE TO TALK TO? – Teachers, Senior Tutors, School Nurses and School Chaplains are always willing to deal with any problems which may arise. Here at St Aidan's and St John Fisher we care about your health and well-being. If something is worrying you it is well known that this can affect other aspects of your life. Talking does help and below are a number of people you can speak to in school about any concerns you may have.

SUBJECT TEACHERS

If you have any specific concerns about an academic subject, you should discuss this with your subject teacher in the first instance.

SENIOR TUTOR

Your Senior Tutor is responsible for your welfare whilst you are at school. You may talk with them about any academic, social and family concerns you have. To contact your Senior Tutor, leave a message in the Sixth Form Office or go to the Senior Tutor's room.

CHAPLAIN

Revd Pete Askew is the Chaplain at St Aidan's and he is in school on three days each week. His room is next to the Medical Room. If you wish to talk with him about anything then he can contact you in school if you ask your Registrar or Senior Tutor or the Medical Room staff to make an appointment for you. Sarah Anteny is the Chaplain at St John Fisher and she is in school full-time. Her room is next to the Smile Room. If you wish to talk with her then she can contact you if you ask your Registrar or Senior Tutor.

MEDICAL ROOM STAFF

Mrs Powell and Mrs Platt at St Aidan's and Mrs Hambly at St John Fisher are all qualified nurses. Their role in school is to look after your medical needs, whether physical or emotional. They are available to chat at break and lunchtimes or can make an appointment for you.

COMMUNITY SCHOOL NURSE

You can talk to the Community School Nurse about any health concerns you may have. An appointment with her can be made through the Medical Room staff.

SOCIAL WORKER

Sarah Lewis is the school social worker at St John Fisher and based in the room next to the Careers Library. You can drop in any Tuesday lunchtime 12.30 – 1.30 or you can arrange an appointment for another time by speaking to Sarah or via your Senior Tutor.
