Spam E-mails

We have had a number of spam emails circulating recently, that appear to come from known contacts. Compromised email accounts will send these spam messages out to every email in the contacts list, so it becomes an ever-expanding problem. Please be cautious when clicking on links or attachments in emails. If you are not expecting an email from someone, it could be malicious spam. Look for strange spelling, attachments and links to unknown websites. If in doubt, delete it or mark it as junk/spam. If you are asked to log in to a webpage, this could be an attempt to steal your password, do not do it. Our current protocol is to disable any accounts that appear to have been hacked. If this happens to you, we will need you to come to the network office and set a new, secure password. As ever, this is an ongoing issue that requires vigilance from everyone.
