## AS Geology Fieldwork, Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> – Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2016

Your son/daughter as part of his/her AS Geology course is due to carry out two days of fieldwork. Students will carry out fieldwork along the Ingleton Waterfalls Walk, study the underground features at White Scar caves (a commercial cave) and finally learn about modern quarrying techniques at a quarry.

The students will be accommodated in rooms of four or six at Ingleton YHA on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> March. Students will need to bring a packed lunch for Wednesday. All other meals (dinner, breakfast and packed lunch for Thursday) will be provided but they may wish to bring a small amount of additional spending money, I would suggest £10.

Transport will be by school minibus, departing from St Aidan's main car park at 8.15am on the 2<sup>nd</sup> March, returning at approximately 5.00 pm on the 3<sup>rd</sup> March. The cost for this visit will be £70.00 per person to cover the cost of accommodation, meals and fuel.

The preferred method of payment is by parent pay however we still accept cheques (made payable to St Aidan's school fund). If you are paying by cheque would you attach it with the consent form and return to the finance department (St Aidan's) by 12<sup>th</sup> February. If you are paying by parent pay then you do not have to fill in the consent form as you can give consent online.

Students need to ensure that they are adequately prepared for the visit with warm clothes, including hat, scarf and gloves, sensible walking shoes, waterproofs and a packed lunch in a small rucksack. They will need a change of clothes, nightwear, wash kit and a towel. Please pack overnight items in a separate small bag to be left in the van during the day. There will be no access to these bags until we arrive at the hostel. The students will be working on the Wednesday evening so they will need to bring a pen, pencil, ruler and a clipboard if they have one. Please note that students will not be allowed to smoke or drink alcohol.
