Dear Year 8 Pupils and Parents

<u>ULLSWATER OUTWARD BOUND - 5 - 9 DECEMBER AND 12 - 16 DECEMBER 2016</u>

I write to inform you of the arrangements made for the Year 8 trip to Ullswater. Just to confirm the pupils will be allocated the following weekends depending on their form:

5 - 9 DECEMBER: C, D, E and G 12 - 16 DECEMBER: P, S, W and Y

The final payment of £145.00 for this trip is due shortly. The total cost of the trip is £290.00 including the payment of £145.00 which you have already paid. Our preferred method of payment for this trip is via ParentPay. Please note payments by cheque will still be accepted and if this is your preferred method of payment, please complete the consent slip below and return it to reception at school with your payment. All payments must be returned by Thursday 13^{th} October. If you have already paid in full then just ignore the payment request.

To allow me to split pupils into activity groups I need to have some idea of friendship groups and ask that you complete the consent form identifying up to 4 friends. I will of course try to meet as many requests as possible but cannot promise that you will be with **all** of your nominated friends.


BEFORE THE PUPILS ARRIVE AT THE CENTRE AT ULLSWATER THEY HAVE TO FILL IN THE ATTACHED FORMS (ENROLMENT, MEDICAL, CONSENT AND PARTICIPANT QUESTIONNAIRE). WOULD YOU PLEASE ENSURE THAT THEY ARE COMPLETED AND RETURNED TO RECEPTION TOGETHER WITH THE CONSENT FORM DETAILING YOUR FRIENDSHIP GROUPS AND MONEY IF YOU ARE PAYING BY CHEQUE.

The Centre provides the equipment required for the day's activities including hiking boots and waterproofs. Specialist additional clothing is, therefore, not required. The message really is to take plenty of warm, old clothing. Avoid new clothes and please note that denim jeans, jackets etc are not suitable for activities, although one pair of jeans to wear in the evening is fine. Bedding is provided so there is no need to take a sleeping bag. A bin bag to take damp clothing home is a good idea. There is a kit list attached also. A £10 REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT WILL BE TAKEN FROM EACH PUPIL UPON ARRIVAL WHICH WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN THEY HAND IN THEIR CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT BORROWED.

I have received several queries about whether pupils will be permitted to take mobile phones. With many years' experience of running this trip, we have a strong preference that pupils do not take a mobile phone with them. One of our aims for the visit is to promote independence and traditionally we have discouraged phoning home during the week. The potential problems that may arise with pupils taking mobiles are considerable and they are unnecessary on this trip. Items such as IPod/IPad should not be taken to the centre. **Insurance cover will not include personal belongings of this type.**




