Please note: Students who sit exams outside of the main exam venue - eg those who use a word processor, reader or scribe etc for their exams should check the seating plans displayed on the exams noticeboard in the Sixth Form café and outside CGH to see which room their exam will be in.

Reminder to students:-

- 1. **Please note the time and date of your examination very carefully.** Check with other people in the group.
- Check your Statement of Entry carefully. Keep it in a safe place. This tells you what information the Examination Board has about you. Make sure it is correct. See me if it is not. The Centre Number for St Aidan's and St John Fisher Associated Sixth Form is 48239. Learn your Candidate Number – you need to put it on each of your exam papers. Y12 – please note that this is a different number from the one you were allocated in Y11.
- 3. You must wear your ID badge to all exams.
- 4. You must be outside the examination room at least 15 minutes before the examination is due to start.
- 5. You must make sure that you have everything you need: pens, pencils, rulers, calculator (without the lid), mathematical instruments etc.
- 6. **Do not bring mobile phones, iWatches or other electronic devices** into the examination room. The Awarding Bodies will disqualify you if you have these on your person.
- 7. Cans of drink or bottles of fizzy drink are not permitted; however clear bottles of water are allowed into the exam room, **provided all labels have been removed from the bottle.** Discreet sucking of sweets is permitted but again all packaging must have been removed.
- 8. Do not leave valuables in bags, for exams in CGH you will need to leave your belongings (coats & bags) in PE2.
- 9. Make sure that you read the "Information to Candidates" notice displayed outside the exam room.
- 10. Please let your subject teachers know in advance if you will be missing their lessons.
- 11. Please let me know as soon as possible if there are any problems.
- 12. In the event of an emergency during an examination we will evacuate as follows:

13. In the event of illness, or if you are delayed for a genuine reason, you should:

- (b) You may have to ask your doctor for a medical certificate which the school will send to the Awarding Body if an appeal for special consideration is to be made on your behalf. You must do this quickly: appeals have to be made promptly.
