Details and Timings

We will depart from St Aidan's main school car park at 10:00 on Sunday 9 July, returning late afternoon/evening time of Sunday 16 July. I will encourage students to phone with a more accurate time as we travel back that day.

Equipment

Please be aware that as we are travelling by school minibus, there will be very little space for luggage. Therefore, students should limit their luggage as much as possible. Bags will be on the bus with students at their feet/on their knees etc.
