### **General Information**

#### **Mobile Phones**

Students and parents may be aware from correspondence in the Summer Term of the new mobile phone policy in the main school at St Aidan's, the intention of which is to limit mobile phone use and abuse in school. The policy for the Sixth Form is slightly different and staff will not be asked to confiscate phones from Year 12 and 13 students but we are keen that you act as role models in support of this policy:

- Students should not use mobile phones in lessons unless the teacher gives permission for them to use the phone for learning purposes. Mobile phones should therefore be switched off and put away at the start of each lesson.
- Sixth Form students have their own social areas on both sites and these are the most appropriate places for you to use mobile phones when not in lessons. If you have to use a phone elsewhere on the school site, please be discreet where possible in the light of the policy on mobile phones for students in Years 7 to 11.
