Max Edwards, otherwise known as The Anonymous Revolutionary, was a young writer who wrote about revolutionary socialism in today's climate. His book was published in 2016 as a collection of articles from his blog by the same name. Max sadly passed away not long after his book was published at the age of 16. With the agreement of his family the Max Edwards Internship has been set up in his memory, offering two weeks paid work experience in the Westminster office of Ed Miliband MP to young people between the ages of 18-25 who are inspired by politics and particularly politics of the left. The dates for the work experience will be set according to the successful candidate's availability. Applications opened on 11 September and close on 1 November.
