The representative will have a week to write a 300 word review of the performance and they will receive personalised feedback from Rachel Auty, Harrogate Theatre's Head of Communications on how to improve their writing. The best written review for each show will be published by the Harrogate Advertiser (online and in print subject to available space). All reviews are published on Harrogate Theatre's website and shared on social media. This is a great opportunity to develop your writing skills as well as see some shows for free. The ability to write concise, objective, original and engaging evaluations to a DEADLINE will provide strong evidence of very transferable skills and an added edge for pursuing a range of career choices.
