

Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award – Assessed Expedition Weekend 7th- 8th July

Following the successful completion of the practice expedition, the next stage is the assessed expedition.

Participants need to be dropped off at the start point of the expedition on Saturday morning between 09:45 and 10:00. They will need to be collected from the finish point on Sunday. Please be on standby from 14:00, we will advise students to contact you when they are approximately one hour from their finish point. The final payment of £70 is now due. A request has been set up on parent pay or please provide a check to St Aidan's School. Please send payment and return the signed consent form below by Friday 29th of June.

- Students to be dropped off between 09:45 and 10:00am at their start point please.
- Groups will be issued with group kit and will set off at their allotted time.
- Groups will walk unaccompanied but will be under observation by an assessor throughout the day.
- Students will arrive at the campsite where they will finalise the following day's route, cook and camp.
- BXM and St Aidan's Staff will be camping on site.

Sunday

- Students will prepare breakfast, pack up and depart from 08:00am.
- Groups will walk unaccompanied but will be under observation by an assessor throughout the day.
- Pupils will be asked to contact home approximately one hour before they expect to arrive at their finish location, but please be on standby from 14:00.

Notes

- Pupils are required to bring with them enough food for lunch on both days, breakfast and an evening meal that they must cook. They have decided in their groups what they will need. They are not allowed to buy food during the day. Water will be available on the campsite and if necessary from staff throughout the day.
- Pupils will be camping where other groups and the public will also be staying, so suitable behaviour goes without saying.
- Pupils must undergo a debrief and be signed out by a member of staff before being collected by parents.

Kit

- If pupils need to borrow any kit for their expedition, such as a rucksack or waterproofs, this must be ordered prior to the expedition. Please come and see Mr Kirkpatrick in DT5 for a kit booking form. Kit can then be collected from LES on Thursday 5th July between 15:45 and 16:30.





