Final Information for the Year 7 Trips to Northumberland, October 2018

As the Year 7 trips to Northumberland approach, please find below the final details and information which may be useful.

- Forms C, D, E, G and H will leave the morning of **Monday 1 October 2018** and return around 16:30 on **Wednesday 3 October 2018**
- Forms P, S, W and Y will follow the same program leaving St Aidan's on **Wednesday 3 October 2018** and returning around 16:30 on **Friday 5 October 2018**.

Medication

It is important that we are aware of any medication that your child takes out of school hours. All medication <u>must come into school</u> with your child on departure date, clearly marked with their **name**, **dosage and times the medication is required.**

Packed Lunch on Departure Day

As we are visiting Holy Island on the way to the Centre, your child <u>must bring a packed lunch to school</u> <u>with them</u> on their day of departure for Northumberland. As a special note of caution, please note that a few of the pupils taking part in the trip have a <u>nut allergy</u> and we ask that both pupils and parents do not pack any items <u>containing nuts of any kind</u>.

- Wellington boots (in a plastic carrier bag), sensible walking shoes or trainers
- Jeans or old trousers will be useful for the activities
- Waterproof Coat
- Hat, Gloves
- Toiletries, Nightwear, Towel


Money, Chewing Gum and Sweets
