## Year 7 exam week: Monday 3rd - Thursday 6th June 2019

Year 7 will have an exam week from Monday 3rd - Thursday 6 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ June 2019.
The exams will take place in normal lesson time in the students' classrooms. A timetable has been produced to show when each exam will take place (see overleaf).

In some lessons students will not have exams and they will be expected to bring their normal books and equipment for these lessons. In particular students should bring their PE kits as normal. Please note English will not be having an assessment during exam week.

The main aim of the exams is to help students to begin to build the skills needed to sit a set of 'terminal' exams. This means developing strategies to help revise a large amount of work for several subjects all at once. To help with this, subject teachers will be giving advice about how and what to revise for their subject and we will be discussing revision and organisation in form time and assembly. We understand that it takes time to develop these skills and students may not get it right first time but it's important that all students attempt some revision.

Year 7 MFL exams will be individually timetabled during the last 3 weeks of term and students will have their maths summative assessment carried out during the week beginning Monday $17^{\text {th }}$ June.

The results of the exams will be used in conjunction with assessments done over the course of the year to help organise teaching groups for next year. The results will also be used to help teachers make a judgement about the progress students have made, which will be reported to you at the end of the year.
