


## **FAREWELL TO YOU ALL**




Adjusting harnesses, helmuts and safety instructions before heading to the first gate.






## Course number one – here we come!








Latched on and scooting up the climbing wall.








Lizzie and Darcy contemplating the last rope course for the morning.








The students went through five different ropes courses and had to learn to latch on and off using the carabiner and a figure 8 attachment to keep them safe at all times.
