What can we say? It is always hardest for the girls. Please don't think that if you weren't cast, you weren't good enough. The number of female roles doubled with the choice of production but the response was that twice as many girls auditioned!

1. Of the hundreds that auditioned the vast majority were girls so competition was extreme.
2. Some cast members have 2 or 3 roles. It may look like this could have been shared out more. However, some characters appear only fleetingly and if we gave a performer one of these roles then they would spend 90% of their time back stage. We really do not feel that this would have been a rewarding experience. The production is structured to include multi-roling and we have made the decision to stick with this format so that every cast member can feel they are fully part of the show.
3. There is a **myth** that productions are for sixth form only. THIS IS NOT, AND NEVER HAS BEEN TRUE. We would like to stress again that the annual production is NOT assigned to particular year groups. Auditions are open to the year groups appropriate to the playing range of the character list. Having said this, for various reasons, we are unable to draw on Year 9 talent for this production. We are looking into alternative performance opportunities for Year 9 later in the school year.

We know there will be disappointments but be lovely to each other whether or not you have been offered a role. We are trusting that any / all information shared regarding the school production will be done in a respectful manner.
