Final Information for the Year 7 Trips to the Bushcraft, Wednesday 2 October to Friday 4 October 2019

As the Year 7 trip to the Bushcraft approaches, please find below the final details and information, which may be useful.

Payment

The total payment for the trip is now due and should be paid in full via ParentPay – if you do not have your ParentPay login details, please contact Mrs Holey in the Finance Office. Thank you if you have already paid for the trip.

Medication

It is important that we are aware of any medication that your child takes out of school hours. All medication <u>must come into school</u> with your child on departure date, clearly marked with their **name**, **dosage and times the medication is required**.

Departure time

We will be leaving school at 09:00 on Wednesday 2 October 2019 – please make sure you arrive at school on time.

Clothing Requirements

ESSENTIAL ITEMS

Large rucksack (or alternative bag/suitcase) AND small rucksack for daytimes away from camp Footwear (at least 2 pairs e.g. walking boots/old trainers) Warm sleeping bag (season 3 recommended) Roll mat Wash bag including toothbrush, toothpaste and face wipes Tracksuit/hard-wearing trousers / T-Shirts / Warm jumpers/fleece Waterproofs (jacket and trousers) Insect repellant (suitable for midges/mosquitos/ticks) Warm socks and underwear Towel(s) Water bottle Good torch with fresh batteries (head torch is ideal) Alcohol hand gel

OPTIONAL ITEMS

Sleeping bag liner / Pillow / Whistle WEATHER DEPENDENT ITEMS Wellington boots / Sun hat / Warm hat /gloves / Sun cream





Money, Chewing Gum and Sweets

The students do not need to bring any money with them. Pupils must not **bring with them any chewing gum or sweets**. We do not permit eating on the coach or in the tents.

Mobile Phones

With many years' experience of running trips, we ask that pupils <u>do not</u> take a mobile phone with them. The Bushcraft does not have any phone coverage on site for pupils. One of our aims for the visit is to promote independence and traditionally we have discouraged phoning home during the week. The potential problems that may arise with pupils taking mobiles are considerable and they are unnecessary on this trip.

Items such as an IPod/IPad <u>should also not</u> be taken on the trip. Our **School Insurance will <u>not</u> include personal belongings of this type.**
