Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award

Dear Parent/Guardian

I am delighted to confirm that your son/daughter has been accepted onto the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award scheme and hope they find it a truly rewarding experience.

The Bronze Award is broken down into four elements: Volunteering; Physical; Skill; and Expedition.

Participants are responsible for organising and undertaking the first three elements, information about this is available on the www.dofe.org website.

The expedition will be organised for them, but there is a certain amount of planning and preparation that they will be expected to do in their own time. The expeditions will be run by BXM Expeditions and will be conducted locally accompanied by St Aidan's Staff. More information will be issued closer the time.

The expedition dates are as follows:

Training Weekend - 16th and 17th May 2020 (non residential)

Assessed Expedition - 4th and 5th July 2020 (residential)

The total cost of the award is £180 and this will be broken down into three payments. The first payment, a registration fee of £40 is due by Friday 6th December. A request has been set up on your parent pay account, or please provide a cheque made payable to "St Aidan's School" to Mr Kirkpatrick in DT5. Receipt of this payment will confirm the acceptance of your place on the Bronze Award. Following this, your daughter/son will be contacted via their school e-mail from eDofE with details of their online account.


