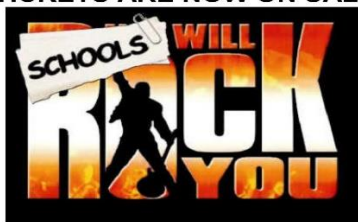
Chocolate Bonfire Bonanza - Zawadi
