UCAS Deadline

Any outstanding UCAS/Conservatoire/FE applications **MUST** be handed in to the Sixth Form Office by Wednesday 4 December; otherwise, we cannot guarantee these will be processed by the official UCAS January deadline. You should print out a hard copy of your application, attach a cover sheet (available from Careers Dept) and bring both to the Sixth Form Office.

Year 13 Mock Exams

Y13 mock exams begin on Wed 4 December. Seating lists for the first day are now up in the Sixth Form café and will be displayed here, outside CGH and the Collins Entrance at SJF prior to all exams.

Exams will start at 9.00 am and 1.30 pm every day so please arrive at least 15 mins prior to this start time. The Attendance Officer will know you are in an exam so you **should not** go to your form to register beforehand. The exams will be run as a rehearsal for the "real thing" so please ensure:

- Any bags, coats, mobile phones, iPods, MP3s etc. are left in PE2 if your exam is in CGH. For exams in other rooms, you may leave your bags on the shelves outside the Careers Lecture Room and your valuables in the Sixth Form Office.
- Remove all labels from water bottles brought in to the exam hall/room.
- Please ensure you bring everything you will need for your exam (eg black pen, pencil, eraser, ruler, calculator (if permitted, without the lid) etc.) and these items should be in a clear pencil case/plastic bag
- No watches are permitted.
- **Please ensure you have your ID lanyard for all exams so the invigilators can identify you.**
- Please ensure you check your seat number prior to entering the exam hall and then sit at the correct desk.
