Duke of Edinburgh Gold Award - Practice Expedition

The Duke of Edinburgh Gold Award groups will undertake their practice expedition from 27th to the 29th March in the Yorkshire Dales. The cost of the expedition is £60.

We depart St Aidan's <u>at 7am</u> on Friday 27th March and travel to the Dales by coach.

Students need to be collected from their finish points on Sunday 29th of March.

- KSK groups finish at the Auction Mart at Leyburn (grid reference 113 907)
- EMP groups finish at Pinker's Pond, Coverdale (grid reference 114 869)

We suggest that you arrive at the finish point for 3:30pm on the Sunday afternoon; however, each group will follow a different route at a different pace, so we cannot provide an exact finish time. We may contact you if groups are due to finish much earlier or later. There are various walks nearby and Leyburn has quite a few cafes. Please do lift share where possible and if transportation home from the expedition causes problems, do not hesitate to contact us.

The practice expedition is a physically demanding, self sufficient, three-day walking expedition. Participants will be walking and camping, unaccompanied, in groups of five to seven, and will be remotely supervised by members of staff who stay nearby. It is a Duke of Edinburgh requirement that participants be self-reliant during the expedition and therefore the purchase of food and drink and use of mobile phones is not permitted. Students need only bring a mobile phone if they are one of two designated emergency contacts within their group. We would appreciate your support in this matter and ask you not to contact your son/daughter via their mobile during the expedition.


