To request a review of marking of an exam paper – 12 noon on Thursday 13 February 2020

To request the return of an exam script for revision purposes – 12 noon on Friday 14 February 2020

Forms are available on the school website or from Mrs Humphrey, Exams Officer in the Sixth Form Office at St Aidan's.

### Exam re-sit entries for June 2020 (GCSE English/Maths & any Level 3 Applied subjects)

If there are any students who wish to be entered for a re-sit exam in June 2020, they **must complete a re-sit form now as a matter of urgency** and return this to Mrs Humphrey with the appropriate fee by **Friday 14 February at the very latest**. Forms are available from the school websites or the Sixth Form Office at St Aidan's and St John Fisher. The school exam entries will be submitted to the Awarding Bodies on Friday 14 February and any requests for re-sits after this date will incur penalty fees.
