Year 11 support for students:

Year 11 should always feel that they can access help from their teachers; a quick conversation at the start/end of lessons is often enough to resolve outstanding questions; some teachers will suggest meeting outside class if they think it will help.

Further help may be sourced from revision guides, text books and on-line support. Details of these resources were sent in the Autumn term and are on our school website <u>here</u>.

Some departments will run a regular, scheduled drop in or revision classes during lunch or after school. These may have a specific focus or be led by students' questions.
