## UCAS Apply 2021

UCAS Apply 2021 is now live for you to complete a digital UCAS application form ready for submission through school from 8 September. (Please note: Apply for UCAS Conservatoires 2021 opens on 16 July).

- Before you can fill out the online form you will need to complete a two-step process to register your application with both UCAS and school. To guide you through this we have produced a step-by-step guide to registering for UCAS Apply together with some FAQ's and an example of a completed application form.
