We are very proud of our outstanding reputation and commitment to Extra-Curricular sport. I am pleased to say that our programme will start on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September. Each year group will come down on their own afternoon. This will ensure there is no mixing between the year group bubbles. All the equipment used will be disinfected before and after each session to limit any spread of COVID-19. We would like to encourage pupils to attend different activities and try new ones out. In previous years pupils could attend 3-4 different clubs per week, due to the protocols they can only attend on one afternoon so trying different activities each week is encouraged. We will be offering a wide range of activities and each session will be following the National Governing Body COVID guidelines for that sport.

Pupils do not have to sign up to activities. Please just turn up to the changing rooms on the correct evening with the kit you need for that sport and follow the teacher's instructions. For most activities you will need to following kit:
