### **Community Relations**

It has been a pleasure to welcome students back into school this week. However, we have already received a number of complaints from local residents regarding student behaviour in the community and we would be grateful for your support and co-operation in maintaining positive relations with our neighbours.

In particular, please note the following:

- Concerns have been reported about students driving at speed along St Ronan's Road – a cul-de-sac with a blind corner - and parking on the pavements there on both sides of the road, causing problems with access for elderly residents or for parents with young children. **Please do not park on St Ronan's Road.**
- It is not appropriate to gather in large groups, especially at this time. The areas where this has been reported are Park Edge and footpaths adjacent to the Stray, in some cases blocking paths from members of the public. **Clearly it is not appropriate to meet as a group off site anywhere in the local area at this time.**

We understand that you will want to catch up with friends and we know that most of you are sensitive to the concerns about the impact of coronavirus which are prevalent, not to mention the legal restrictions in place. Please show your respect for the local community by observing the requests above.
