RE: Sixth Form Registration, EEP and Tutorials,

We are really looking forward to welcoming all students back into school and continue to try to minimise the impact of coronavirus (Covid-19) on our students' education whilst at the same time prioritising the safety of our entire school community.

For the remaining three weeks of this term we are removing the requirement for students to attend registration period, EEP
and Tutorial lessons. This will remove points of potential contact with other students and will also reduce the likelihood of
periods of self-isolation that may be required because of contact tracing. Important topics which were to be explored in
these sessions will now be added to the Tutorial Programme for the Summer Term and students should read the weekly
notices carefully to ensure they access information which will be available from the Careers Department.

Therefore, from Monday 8 March, we do not expect students to attend registration, EEP or Tutorials

- Our registration system will use the first period a student attends as the statutory registration mark for the day.
- We expect that this suspension of the registration period, EEP and Tutorials will be in place until Easter at which point it will be reviewed. Senior Tutors will continue to ensure that they are accessible when required to support, and students should continue to make contact with them as normal.

Use of the café/marquee

We are continuing to alternate the use of the café and marquee on a weekly basis. Please note the change:

- Week 1
 - **Year 13** will have use of the cafe for the week. They will have lunch first and vacate the cafe from 12.55 in order that Year 12 can get lunch and the cafe be cleaned. Year 12 will have exclusive use of the Sixth Form side of the marquee.
- Week 2
 - **Year 12** will have use of the cafe for the week. They will have lunch first and vacate the cafe from 12.55 in order that Year 13 can get lunch and the cafe be cleaned. Year 13 will have exclusive use of the Sixth Form side of the marquee.

Please note there is now only 1 entrance to the cafe for the year group having lunch second. Students need to queue up sensibly from 12.50 alongside the cafe windows that run parallel to the bike shed. They will then have access to the cafe to purchase lunch or sit and eat their own lunch.

A reminder to all students that from 12.30-1.00 they may use their period 3 classroom and from 1.00-1.30 they may use their period 4 classroom. The yeargroup who are in the cafe may also use the 'non-Sixth Form' part of the marquee from 1.30-2.00 whilst the cafe is being cleaned. No Sixth Form students should be in the 'non-Sixth Form' part of the marquee during the lunch hour.
