#### Gap Year – averages



- 200,000-250,000 young people take a gap year
- 27,500 students defer their degree
- 140,000+ travel abroad during the 12 months
  - the Far East/Australia are the most popular destinations
- It can cost up to £22,000+ for a travelling 12 month gap year
