Home Testing

Thank you to those who are continuing to do their Covid tests at home. Remember to report your home test result each time: to St. Aidan's at https://hometest.staidans.co.uk and to NHS Test and Trace at https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result. If you need to report a PCR test result, please use the covid@staidans.co.uk email address. Reporting can be done at any time, including out of hours and it is important that positive results especially are reported as soon as possible, and anyone who tests positive must start self-isolating immediately.

Please also remember that negative home test results do NOT change the requirement to follow all other Covid control measures, including that no-one should be in school if they, or anyone in their household(s) or support bubble, have any of the coronavirus (Covid-19) symptoms, or if they have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive.
