Topic(s): Applied Anatomy and Physiology, Skill Acquisition and Socio Cultural Issues in Sport

Independent Learning Task(s) to Complete:

Evaluation and Analysis of Sport.

- 1. Select a sporting skill For example; a long pass in football, a shot in netball, a tumble turn in swimming etc.
- 2. You must then find the following information about that skill:
 - Physiology: Identification of joint type (s) and its movement range(s), identification of muscles involved and the type of movements and contractions.
 - o **Biomechanics:** Importance/relevance of Newton's Laws in the performance and analyse lever systems in operation during the skill.
 - Psychology: Classification of the skill/technique on the skill continuum and Information processing demands on the performance.
- 3. Put this information into a document and bring to the first lesson.

Task 1: Research 3 of the following Olympics and describe in a table how these games were politically exploited.

- a) Berlin 1936
- b) Mexico City 1968
- c) Munich 1972
- d) Moscow 1980
- e) L.A 1984

Task 2 - Hosting the 2012 Olympics in London.

Think about the benefits and drawbacks of hosting a global event such as the Olympics. Write a newspaper article to demonstrate the impact of hosting the Olympics by London in 2012.
