ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE START OF TERM

As we move into the final week of term this letter outlines the arrangements for the start of term for Year 13.

A small number of students will have external summer results emailed to them, as previously outlined, should these summer results raise concerns about Year 13 options then students should contact the Sixth Form Office on Thursday 2 or Friday 3 September to arrange a consultation with their Senior Tutor.

Covid testing will take place for Year 13 students on the afternoons of Wednesday 1 September and Monday 6 September in line with Mr Ives' letter and Covid Testing Schedule sent separately.

All Year 13 students should then return to school for the new term on Wednesday 8 September at 8.45. A list of form rooms will be displayed in the Sixth Form café and students should then go straight to their form rooms.

Please note that the deadlines for Higher Education applications come round very quickly in the Autumn Term: Conservatoire applications for Music have to be completed by Monday 13 September, Oxbridge and Medicine applications have to be completed by Friday 24 September, and other University applications are due by Monday 18 October. It is therefore essential that students are efficient in their future planning and completion of application forms.

Finally, a reminder that there is no parking space on either school site for students. Students who need to use cars or motorbikes to come to school are asked to park off-site and should not use their vehicles during the school day. We ask that students register their vehicles with the Sixth Form Office so that they can be contacted if necessary.
