Year 12 & Year 13 – Applied Subject unit exams taking place in January 2022

Seating lists for the exams on 11 and 12 January are currently displayed on the exams noticeboard in the Sixth Form café at SA and the Collins Entrance at SJF. Lists for later exams will be displayed at least the day before an exam. Please check your seat number.

Exam Numbers – these are listed next to names on the seating lists and it is **VERY IMPORTANT** that all students make a note of their 4-digit Exam Number (you could write this on the back of your photo ID lanyard) as **you will need to include this on your exam paper**. Exam Numbers for Year 12 usually start with a “4” and for Year 13 with a “3”. Please **DO NOT USE** the number you will have been allocated in Year 11 as this is no longer valid.

Please can students:-

- Arrive for their exams at least 15 minutes prior to the start time of the exam and wait outside the Hall/Room allocated until asked to enter by the invigilators.
- Wear their photo ID lanyard so invigilators can identify them.
- Wear a face mask (as currently required in class) unless you are exempt.
- Bring all equipment needed for the exam (e.g. black pen, pencil, ruler, calculator (if applicable and without the lid) in a clear pencil case or bag.
- Remove labels from any water bottles.
- Remember: no mobile phones, watches, MP3/4 players – leave these in your bags in **PE2** if you have an exam in Constance Green Hall.
