Although students may have finished their exams they must be available up to and including the 29 June as this is the Contingency date decided by The Joint Council for Qualifications in the event of widespread sustained national or local disruption to examinations during the summer 2022 examination series. The Contingency date is not a school decision and applies to all candidates in all schools. Please make a note of this Contingency exam date in the event that an awarding body needs to invoke its Contingency plan.
