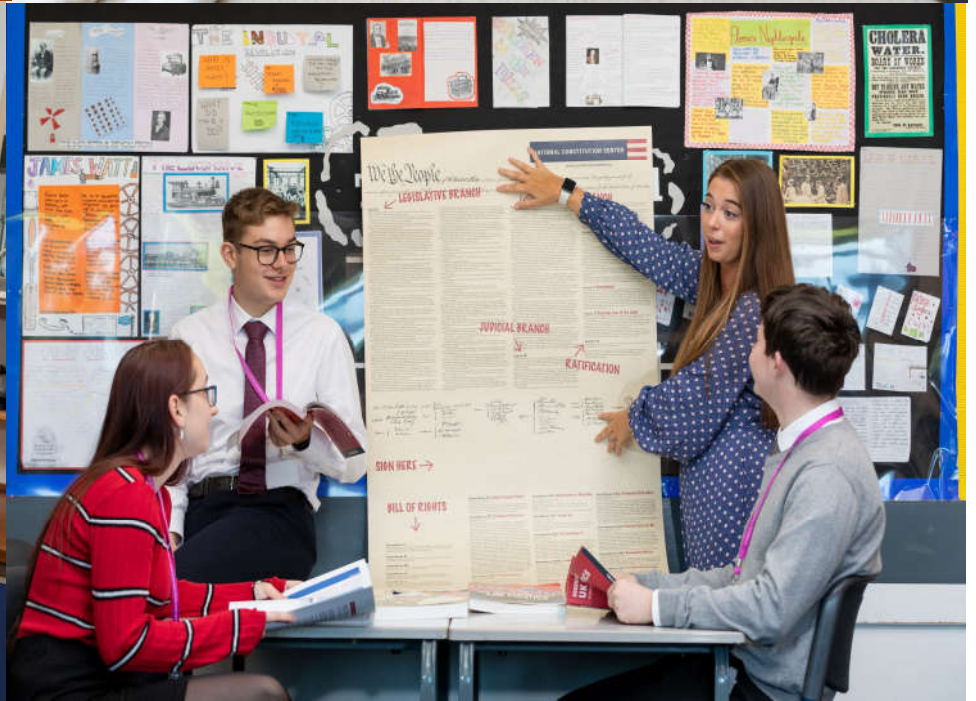

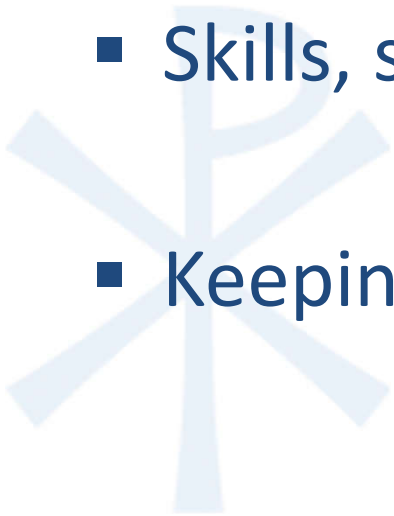

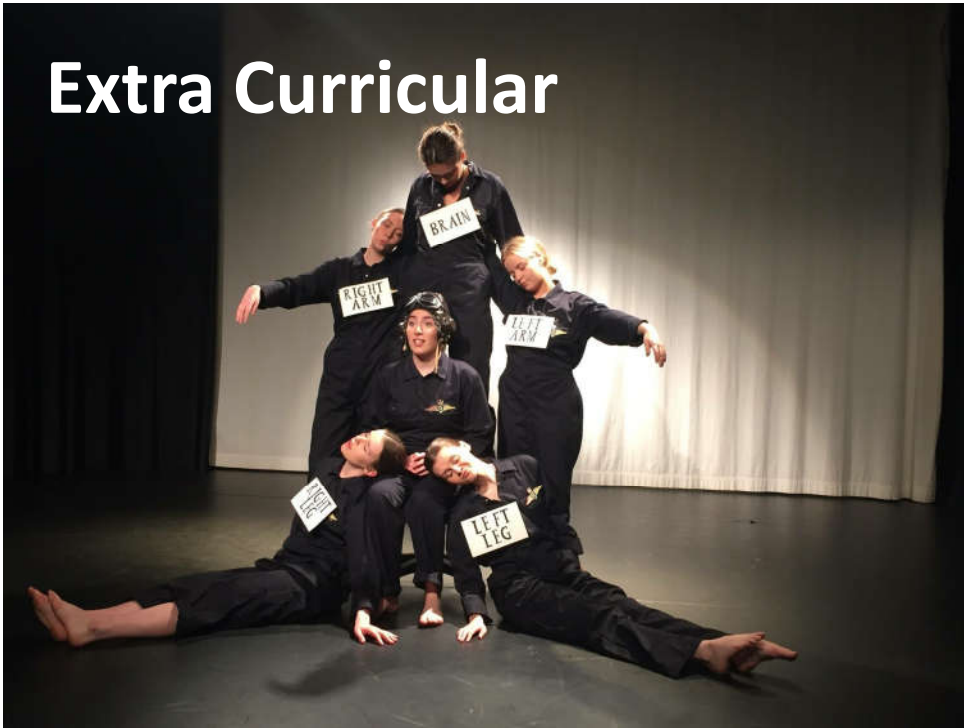
Progression Routes

- 2021: 95% of HE entrants gained 1st or 2nd choice
- 2021: 41% students accepted at Russell Group universities
- 2021: 9 students accepted onto Medicine and Dentistry Courses
