Start the Music was set up in 2019 and provides the opportunity for approximately 6 students from Years 7, 8 and 9 to learn an instrument

Start the Music offers:

- Free individual 20 minute lessons during the academic year
- Tuition by a fully qualified music teacher
- Free instrument (if required) on loan for the duration of the scheme
- Support from the STM team and school
- Ability to join an ensemble at school depending on progress
