Year 12 Update

We hope all Year 12 students enjoyed the Conference. Please can we draw your attention to the following key points raised:

- You can plan and apply for all Post-18 options, (employment, HE, FE or a gap year), at the same time and take your time to consider which is the right option for you
- School leaver employment vacancies, including apprenticeships, start to be advertised in the Autumn of Year 13
- If applying for HE, you can list **UP TO FIVE** courses on your UCAS application
- For some courses, it may be possible to **add additional choices** at a later date
- Once your application has been submitted to UCAS, you **cannot add or remove** any courses outside of their 14 day cooling off period
- We would advise only adding a choice if you are confident that it is for a course and university that you would consider going to if offered a place



UCAS Extra and Clearing

If you included five choices on your application, and are not holding any offers, you will be able to use [UCAS Extra](#). Apply before the **4 July**.

From **5 July – 18 October**, you can apply for a course using [Clearing](#) if you're not already holding an offer from a university or college, and the course still has places. Click on the link below for more details:
