Topic(s): Communication

Independent Learning Task(s) to Complete: Research communication skills

Title: Communication skills

Conduct some research into the following areas;

- **Verbal communication skills:** Pace, tone and pitch, effective questioning, active listening, non-discriminatory language, avoiding slang and jargon and age appropriate language.
- Non-verbal communication skills: Body language, eye contact, touch, gestures and proximity.
- **Special methods of communication:** Makaton, British Sign Language, Braille, deafblind language.
- Technological aids- Dynavox, lightwriters and voice activated software.

How it links to the Specification:
