Art & Design Foundation Diploma: 22nd November

Bulk of Apprenticeships with Autumn start date begin to be advertised: January

Onwards

These are the deadline dates students need to adhere to, rather than dates published on the UCAS website.

In order to submit a UCAS application, you can choose to just include the Universities/Courses you have fully decided on and leave space to add others, once you have made further decisions.

A reminder that once you have used all five choices and they have been processed by UCAS, you **cannot** remove or add others, without declining all your other offers and entering <u>UCAS Extra.</u>

Particularly during the Autumn term, careers appointments can fill up very quickly. If you would like to book a careers appointment to discuss your options and Post 18 applications:

- Remember to let us know if you are unable to attend an appointment, which allows us to offer that slot to another student



REMINDER—<u>UCAT University</u> <u>Admissions Test</u>, Deadline 22 <u>September</u>

If you are intending to study medicine or dentistry, the UCAT is required by the majority of UK universities and booking closes on **22nd September 2022.**
