## Student safety: Pedestrian access to school

The welfare and safety of all students are of paramount importance. As a result of concerns raised about the potential risks involved with students walking across the car park next to Bede House, there will be a change to arrangements for access to the site after half-term.

With effect from Monday 31 October, all students will enter the site via the main pedestrian entrance opposite reception. The side gate from the Bede car park will be re-programmed to allow staff access only. Student ID cards will not work and the pedestrian gate leading into the Bede car park will be closed. This is to stop all students entering the site via this route. We appreciate that this may cause some inconvenience but have to prioritise safety in this situation. Thank you for your understanding and co-operation.

## Parking in the local area

It is important that we maintain good relationships with our neighbours, the local residents and we hope that you will be able to help us in this.

Concerns have been raised recently about students parking partially on pavements (making it difficult for pedestrians to pass, especially if they have a pushchair or are in a wheelchair) and double parking, ie parking opposite another car, (making it difficult for residents to access their driveways or for wider vehicles to pass).

This is particularly a problem on Wheatlands Road East. Therefore, if you park there, please avoid blocking or partially blocking the pavements, make sure that driveways are clear and do not double park. Residents will contact the police if cars are parked without consideration and are causing an obstruction. Thank you for your co-operation.
