#### **Exam Result Information**

- GCSE English & Maths exam certificates from the November 2022 exam series have now arrived in school and can be collected from Mrs Humphrey in the Sixth Form Office in Bede House (for SA students) and from Mrs Mackinnon in the Sixth Form Office at St John Fisher (for SJF students).
- Results for Applied Business and Applied Science units sat in the January 2023 exam series were issued to students on 2 March. If students were not in school on this day they can collect their results from the Sixth Form Office of the school they register with.
- Please note that Cambridge Technical Health & Social Care and IT results are due on 15 March and BTEC Sport and Travel & Tourism results are due on 23 March.
