Update for Post 18 Applications

We are encouraging students to submit either a plan or a first draft of their personal statement to their Senior Tutor by Friday 14th July, for use in their post 18 applications.

Students should continue to undertake activities and reading over the summer, in order to enable them to add to their personal statement during the holidays and then complete it more fully at the start of the Autumn term.

Senior Tutors and the Careers Department will be able to support in September with this process.

Another reminder that there are lots of ways in which you can be preparing for your Post 18 applications by engaging in wider reading, super curricular activities and work experience opportunities, either in person or online. Remember it is quality over quantity and about choosing activities that you are genuinely interested in exploring, which will support your applications and help you to make informed choices about your next steps after Year 13.
