Exam Results Year 12 and Year 13

You will have already received a letter explaining the arrangements for results days. Please note if you are unable to collect your results in person on Thursday 17 August (Level 3 Results) or Thursday 24 August (GCSE Results) and you wish to nominate someone else to collect them on your behalf, you should e-mail Mrs Humphrey (<u>w.humphrey@staidans.co.uk</u>) your authority for us to release your results and to whom. Alternatively, you can leave a large stamped addressed envelope with the correct postage on, in the Sixth Form Office, before 21 July. Unfortunately, we are only able to e-mail results to students in exceptional circumstances on results day.

Post-Results Information (Request forms/Fees applicable and Deadline dates)

These will be available on the SA and SJF school websites ahead of results day for any students who sat exams this summer to use once results are published on 17 August. The 3 main post results deadlines for A Levels/other Level 3 exams that students need to be aware of are:

- 24 August Priority Review of Marking (for students with a place at their chosen University dependent on a grade change)
- 31 August Priority Return of a copy of your exam paper/script (to help students decide whether they wish to get an exam paper reviewed)
- 28 September Review of Marking

Y12 – UCAS Personal Statements

We have encouraged students to submit either a plan or a first draft of their personal statement to their Senior Tutor for use in their post 18 applications. The deadline for this was last Friday.

Students should continue to undertake activities and reading over the summer, in order to enable them to add to their personal statement during the holidays and then complete it more fully at the start of the Autumn term.

Senior Tutors and the Careers Department will be able to support in September with this process.
