Degree Apprenticeships Reminder

Procedure for Sixth Form Work Experience—term time placements only

- Collect the work experience paper consent form from the Sixth Form Office
- Fully complete the form, obtaining the necessary signatures
- Return your form to the Careers Department
- You will then be sent an online form to complete with further details of your placement

Please note the following:

- BOTH FORMS must be submitted at least TWO WEEKS PRIOR to the placement start date
- Failure to comply may mean we are unable to authorise your placement

Year 13 HE and FE Deadlines Reminder


A reminder that the remaining school deadlines for Post 18 applications are as follows:
