
The suggested voluntary contribution to cover all 3 years is £25.

- Use specialist techniques such as Screen Printing, Sublimation Printing and Laser Cutting, which replicates industrial practices.
- Provide Sensory Food Testing and some specialist ingredients for Food Technology lessons.
