Year 11 Work Experience Programme 2023 - 2024

As part of the extended curriculum offered to all pupils, we strongly recommend participation in our optional work experience programme for Year 11 students following exams next May/June. Students are encouraged to arrange one week of work within a **local** (Yorkshire & Teeside) business or organisation.

NB. Please save contacts you may have for work experience in more distant areas of the country for the school holidays or 6th Form.

Placements take place within a 3 week period (July 3rd – July 21st 2023) enabling students to fit in 1 week of work around end of year activities such as Ardeche trips. To allow time for individual risk assessments to be completed, students should confirm details of their placement by **March 1st 2024.**

Work Experience represents an invaluable opportunity to raise confidence and aspirations whilst also enabling students to identify individual work related skills. In addition to gaining a greater understanding of themselves and the workplace during their placement, students will also be able to evidence the research, enterprise, resilience and organisational skills required to successfully apply for and secure a placement by the March 1st deadline.


Our expectation is that students will draw on friends or family contacts in industry sectors they would like to explore. However, to assist, school work closely with NYBEP who provide an new app which students can download containing contact details and job descriptions for placements obtained in previous years. NYBEP also ensure relevant health and safety assessments are carried out for each placement.

Please return the **Parent/Carer Consent Slip** at the end of this letter by October 27th 2023. Once students have registered to take part, by they will receive the following paperwork and assistance:

- 1. **Guide to Applying for Work Experience** handbook including database login details
- 2. **Work Experience Placement Form** (at the back of the handbook) to complete once your placement is secured and dates confirmed with the employer. (Deadline: 1st March 2024)
- 3. **Weekly lunchtime Drop-in sessions** held in the Careers Department from w/c November 6th.

Whilst we appreciate that this is a very busy and important year as students prepare for their exams, we strongly encourage participation in the work experience programme. 94% of students who took part in July 2023 reported a greater belief in themselves following their placement, whilst 95% said they had more confidence in their ability to evidence work related skills in applications or interviews.
