




Year 13 UCAS Submission—What Happens Next..?

- In order to meet the **school deadline of 20 OCTOBER** you can choose to include the courses and institutions you have fully decided on and then add other choices through the **UCAS Hub** once you have made further decisions.
- Deadline for Art & Design Foundation Diploma Applications is 22 NOVEMBER
- PLEASE ALLOW 3 WEEKS FOR YOUR APPLICATION TO BE SENT FROM SCHOOL.
