

## **Course Outline: A Level Fashion & Textiles Year 12**

## Rationale

Students begin the A Level with very varied starting points, including some with limited experience of using machines and making products. Year 12 provides them with the key skills required covering research, design and practical/making delivered alongside theoretical concepts which support the externally examined component of the course. Year 13 is focussed on the NEA and theory content continues.
