It was pleasing to see so many of you at the Year 13 Pastoral Parents' Evening and we hope that the presentations were useful in explaining some of the challenges that lie ahead. We are encouraged by the purposeful way in which students have returned to school, many of them tackling the twin pressures of applications to university alongside their continuing studies.

Your student may have made appointments or may have instruction from their teacher on when to join their TEAMS meeting. Please note that some teachers have more than one class and therefore an appointment may only be possible with one teacher from the subject. As is usual at our well-attended Parents' Evenings, there will be queues to wait in (in a Teams lobby) but I hope that all parents will be able to access a meeting time for every course. Teachers will be fully engaged in the Teams meetings during the evening: please do not email or message them. Please be patient and, if needed, email questions to parentsevening@staidans.co.uk . It is also important that each appointment is not too long; please help the teacher to keep it concise and no longer than 5 minutes. We recommend that a gap of at least five minutes is left between each appointment to ensure they do not clash.

Please see the attached instructions showing how you and your student can access Teams for this event. Remember, if the subject teacher is based at St John Fisher, the student will need to log on to Teams with their St John Fisher email account.
