Year 12 Work Experience Reminder

Year 12 students may request up to 5 days, UK based, In-Person and/or Virtual work experience – dates MUST avoid internal/external assessment and subject related trips. Application forms for both In Person and Virtual work experience are available from the Sixth Form Office and are subject to the agreement of Parents, Senior Tutor/Head of Year and Subject Teachers.

Please note:

- <u>In Person Work Experience Process</u> We require at least **TWO weeks notice** of In Person placements in order to carry out safeguarding checks.
- <u>Virtual Work Experience Process</u> We have data sharing agreements with most of the large virtual work experience host organisations, however please give as much notice as possible of any virtual placements secured, in case safeguarding checks are required.
- Failure to comply may mean we are unable to authorise the student absence. Full details can be found in our <u>Work Experience Policy</u>.
