GCSE PE

I would like to communicate some key deadline dates and information for our GCSE PE students in Year 11. **Monday the 11th December 2023** the students will need to submit the following;

1) The final version of their coursework, the Personal Exercise Programme

- To be handed in on the Team assignment by 5pm on **Monday 11th December**
(A powerpoint with the full instructions for how to complete the coursework and a checklist can be found on Teams)
- All students have received a marked copy of their coursework with feedback to be used for improvements.
- Every Thursday in DL at 12.35 – 1pm there will be a member of the PE staff on hand to help students with the completion of their coursework.

- 2) Any students who are **submitting video evidence for their practical sporting performances** will need to hand these in on the **11th December**, either via the Teams assignment in the group GCSE PE Video evidence 2022-2024, or save them onto a named memory stick with each video clip appropriately labelled and give this into the PE department. All parents/guardians should have received guidance on what needs to be included in the videos via an email, if the student has notified us of their activity choice. If this is not the case, please let Miss Wadhams know as soon as possible. The assessment criteria for all sports can be found on the PE group Teams or on the Edexcel website, which must be followed. If game footage is being submitted it must be continuous footage and not clips, the Exam Board therefore asks for this footage to be accompanied with a story board / timeline of when the student is in action and a description of how to identify them (yellow shirt number 12).

It is essential that if the sporting performance cannot be shown live on the moderation day in April that video evidence is supplied.

When is a video not required

- Activities such as netball, hockey, football, table tennis and badminton do not require video evidence as we will video the students in their lessons and these sports can be shown live on the moderation day in April, on the school site.
- Athletics, the PE department has collected the video evidence for the students from the York University day.
- Swimming, Miss Wadhams will arrange a swimming session for students to attend if they wish (there will be a payment involved to cover the cost of hiring the pool), the date for this will be confirmed shortly.
- Cricket, this has been filmed for those who attended the GCSE game, there will be a skills session organised, this date is to be confirmed next year.
- Rock climbing, the filming for this activity has been completed during the recently organised sessions at Harrogate climbing wall.
