An Open Day is when a university invites prospective students to look around their campus and ask questions about courses, learning facilities, accommodation and more. Open Days enable you to get a feel for an institution by meeting lecturers, students and staff and gathering the information you need to make an informed decision about whether a course and institution is right for you.
